PRESENTATION/INTERACTIVE SESSION NOTICE

Subject: <u>Presentation and discussions relating to preparation of Action Plan for minimizing Regulatory Compliance burden.</u>

The DPIIT, Government of India, has undertaken the project to take up Regulatory Impact Assessment and obtain Action Plans from all States/Ministries for minimizing Regulatory Compliance burden.

The initiative is aimed at Simplifying, Rationalizing, Digitalizing and Decriminalizing Government-to business and Government-to-Citizen interfaces in order to decrease time and cost burden and improve Ease of Doing Business and Ease of Living for Citizens.

It will comprise two phases - Phase 1 requires regulatory assessment of removals of licenses/certificates/permissions, inspection system, registers & records, which is to be simplified by March 31, 2021. The Phase 2 Action Plan requires Regulatory assessment of laws identified for decriminalization, redundant/archaic laws, which is to be implemented by August 15, 2021.

For minimizing Regulatory Compliance burden in Phase 1, The Department is required to:

- 1. Identify and list out all interface where businesses and citizen have to interact with Government for approvals, clearance, etc. (Comprehensive study of all Acts, Rules and Regulations/process/permissions needs to be conducted)
- 2. Map complete process, procedure of these interfaces w.r.t time and cost taken.
- 3. Understand the periodicity of these interfaces, and assess if the required interval/s can be reduced.

In order to prepare the as-is Report and to be-Action Plan, an interactive session is organized on 24.02.2021 at 02:30 PM in VC's Conference Hall, 1st Floor, B Block, Vikas Sadan, INA in which a presentation will be given by Industries Department, GNCTD (who is coordinating the proposal of Action Plan on behalf of GNCTD), on the objectives, methodology, process and formats for preparation of Phase 1 Action Plan on reduction of Regulatory Compliances burden.

All the HoDs of DDA are requested to attend the presentation and interactive session as per aforesaid mentioned date and time.
