DELHI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY EARLIER STATUS OF WATER BODIES

- A Case was filed in High court of Delhi under writ petition case No. 3502 of 2000 titled as Shri Vinod Kumar Jain Vs GNCTD &Ors for revival of water bodies in Delhi.
- Subsequently a Petition no CCP No. 458/2013 in above W P (C) was filed by the petitioner against Chief Secretary Govt. of Delhi and Ors. wherein DDA was a party as respondent no. 3.
- A Total of 156 water bodies were identified under Jurisdiction of DDA all over Delhi by Petitioner.
- A Committee was constituted by Hon'ble L.G. on dated 07.06.13 under the chairmanship of Sh. S.R. Solanki CE (DWK) to review the progress & restoration of water bodies in Dwarka.
- During the course of various meetings of this committee a list of 24 locations/ water bodies were submitted by Sh. S.S. Mann Member of Committee to Chief Engineer Dwarka. Some of these locations are common with list submitted in the Hon'ble High Court.
